




Set Up a Forum

Create a Thread

Once a forum has been set up, students and teachers can create threads. Click on "Create Thread" to do this.



At the top-right (see picture below), you can see "List View" and "Tree View".

List View	All threads, one after the next (standard).
Tree View	All threads, one after the next – but here you will see a small plus sign (+) to the left of the threads. Click on the plus sign to see posts in this thread. There is also a minus sign (-) that you can use to hide posts.
	d "Tree View", there are the options "Search", "Collapse All" and chosen "List View", then you will see "Search" only.
Search	To look for a key phrase or post written within a certain timeframe.
Collapse All	Hide all answers to the threads.
Expand All	Show all answers in the threads.

This picture shows a forum after you have selected "Tree View" and " Expand All".
