

Activate Urkund in an existing assignment

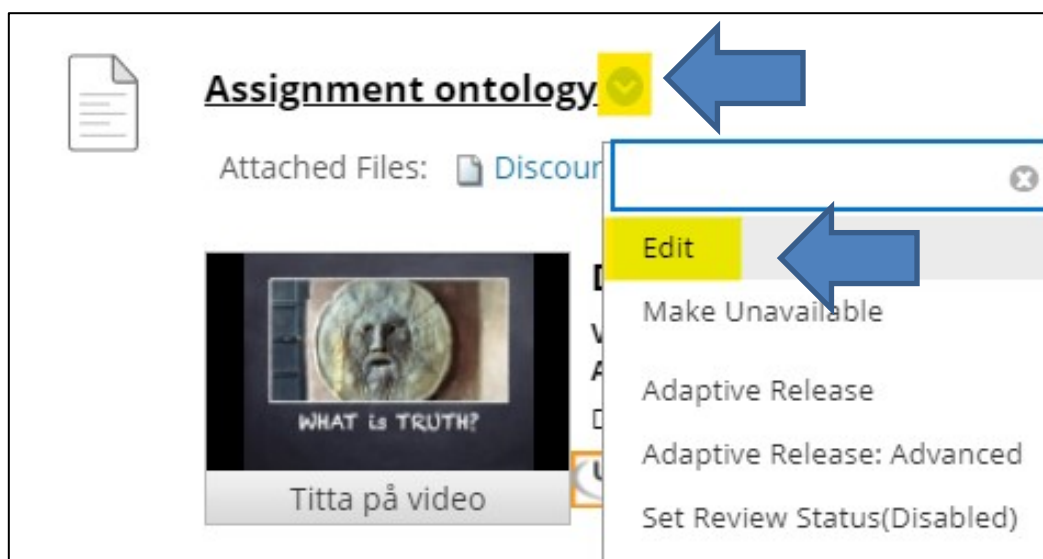
The Urkund integration in Learn makes it possible for you to automatically check for plagiarism in student texts submitted in Learn. This manual explains how to activate Urkund in an existing assignment. This can be done after students have started to hand in texts.

Please NOTE: If marking has begun all students who have been marked will be reset and show up as 'needs marking'. Results and comments do not disappear but can be seen in the student's assignment. However, in this case the teacher needs to go back to Grade Centre and manually rewrite the grade again for its to be visible for the student and in grade centre.

Open the assignment for editing in Learn

Choose an existing assignment where you want to check for plagiarism. Click on the grey circle to the right of the assignment title and choose (click) the alternative 'edit' in the list.

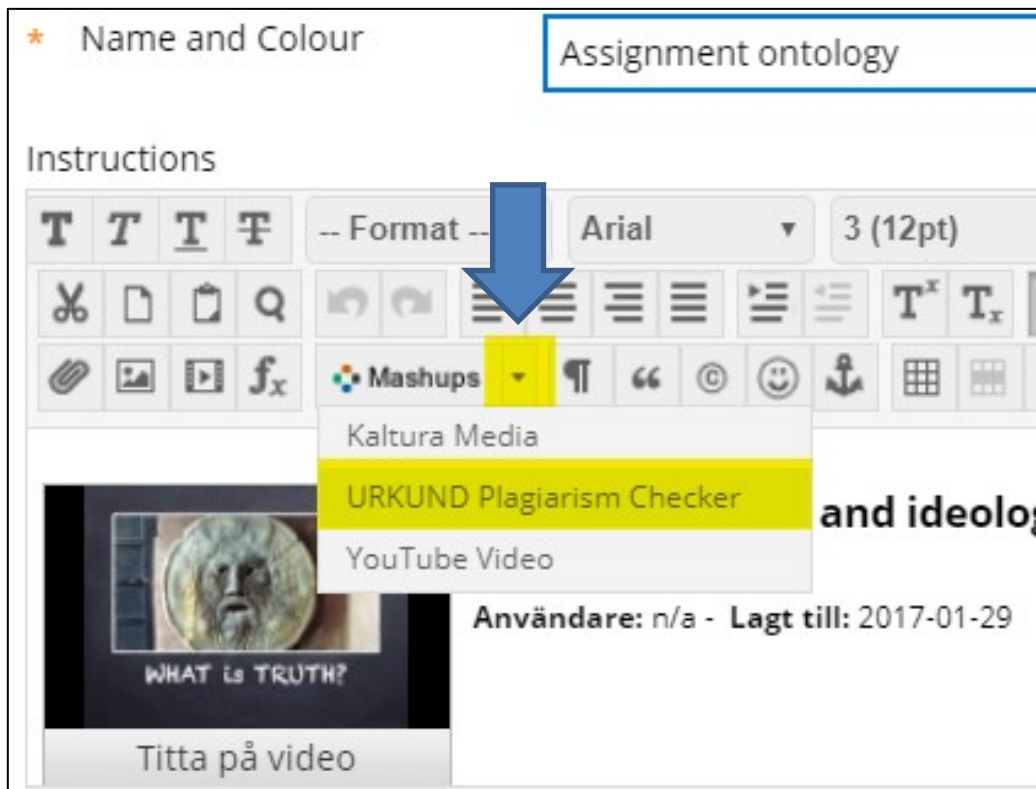

Activate Urkund in the editor

You activate Urkund in the assignment in the editor by clicking 'Mashups' and choosing Urkund.



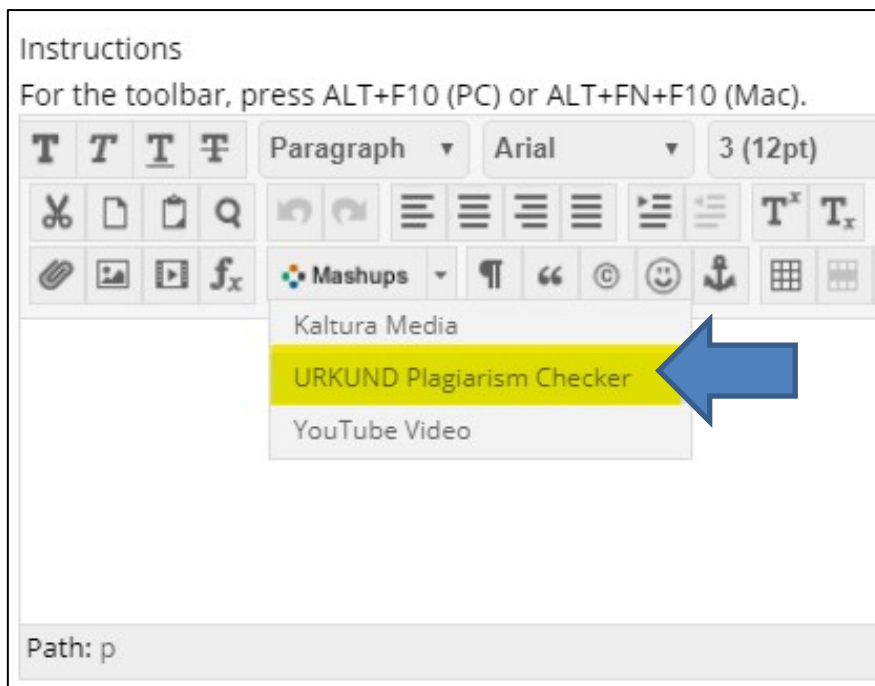
If you cannot see the alternative Mashups as in the image above, then you need to open the editor in the righthand corner (see below).

Choose the tool Urkund

There are three alternatives under Mashups. Choose 'URKUND Plagiarism Checker'.

If you want to see the results of the plagiarism control in a separate column in Grade Centre, then you should tick the box "Include similarity in Grade Center". This is not necessary but will make it easier and clearer as you can see the result for all students in one place.


Urkund can be seen in the assignment
